### DESCRIPTION OF FALSE ALARM FEES/FINES DURING A PERMIT YEAR:

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<b>Alarm User Permit Application Fee</b>	<b>\$ 40</b> (\$10 discount for applying within 30 days of alarm system becoming operative.)
<b>Bi-annual Renewal Fee</b>	<b>\$ 20</b> (\$10 discount for early renewal: 30 or more days prior to alarm permit expiration.)
<b>Alarm Reinstatement Fee</b> <i>(for revoked permits)</i>	<b>\$ 30</b>

#### **False Alarm Fines** (per permit year)

<b>First False Alarm</b>	<b>NO CHARGE</b>
<b>Second False Alarm</b>	<b>NO CHARGE</b>
<b>Excessive False Alarm Fine</b> (per permit year, 3 <sup>rd</sup> incident )	<b>\$ 50</b>
<b>Excessive False Alarm Fine</b> (per permit year, 4 <sup>th</sup> incident and each subsequent false alarm afterwards.)	<b>\$250</b>
<b>Civil Penalties</b>	
<b>All Violations</b>	<b>Up to \$720</b>

**NOTE:** A power outage, low battery signal, or loss of telephone service will result in a false alarm designation to any alarm event that is called into 911. Ensure your alarm company can reach you or a responder during these types of instances, as they are not a valid reason for an appeal.

#### **PLEASE CONTACT OUR OFFICE IF ONE OF THE FOLLOWING APPLIES:**

- If you change your phone service, mailing address, emergency contact information, if you change your name, if your living situation changes.
- If you move or have your alarm system disconnected from power.  
(Submit these changes in writing to our office, as we cannot make these changes over the phone.)
