DESCRIPTION OF FALSE ALARM FEES/FINES DURING A PERMIT YEAR:

Alarm User Permit Application Fee \$ 40

(\$10 discount for applying within 30 days of alarm system becoming

operative.)

Bi-annual Renewal Fee \$ 20

(\$10 discount for early renewal: 30 or more days prior to alarm

permit expiration.)

Alarm Reinstatement Fee \$ 30

(for revoked permits)

False Alarm Fines (per permit year)

First False Alarm NO CHARGE

Second False Alarm NO CHARGE

Excessive False Alarm Fine \$ 50

(per permit year, 3rd incident)

Excessive False Alarm Fine \$250

(per permit year, 4th incident and each subsequent false alarm afterwards.)

Civil Penalties

All Violations Up to \$720

NOTE: A power outage, low battery signal, or loss of telephone service will result in a false alarm designation to any alarm event that is called into 911. Ensure your alarm company can reach you or a responder during these types of instances, as they are not a valid reason for an appeal.

PLEASE CONTACT OUR OFFICE IF ONE OF THE FOLLOWING APPLIES:

- If you change your phone service, mailing address, emergency contact information, if you change your name, if your living situation changes.
- If you move or have your alarm system disconnected from power.
 (Submit these changes in writing to our office, as we cannot make these changes over the phone.)
